This scholarship was made possible by the generous donation of Mrs. Dorothy Cummings.</p> <p>Scholarships are awarded on a competitive basis and must follow the prompt/topic idea.</p> <p>To be considered, a scholarship application is required. Applying does not automatically mean an award.</p>
Funding Details	<p>One (1) - \$2,400 one-time, non-renewable scholarship award, is available per academic term.</p> <p>Scholarships are awarded per academic term. Awarded students may apply for future scholarship opportunities.</p>
Eligibility Requirements	<ul style="list-style-type: none">● Must be an enrolled Doctor of Behavioral Health (DBH) degree-seeking student at CGI for the academic term in which they are applying for the scholarship.● Must be enrolled in a minimum of one (1) credit hour for the academic term.● Must submit a scholarship application by the listed due date with all requested materials
Terms and Conditions	<ul style="list-style-type: none">● This scholarship does not have a cash value.● The scholarship is applied to the awarded student's account after the scholarship has been announced and the student registers for courses. The scholarship will show as a credit in this student's account and be applied towards that term's tuition.● Not subject to a refund. If a refund is needed because the student dropped a course, goes on a Leave of Absence or defers enrollment, the scholarship would sit on their account as a credit for the next term.● Non renewable - one time scholarship.● Awarded students may apply for future scholarship opportunities● If a student receives a scholarship credit and then withdraws from the institution, the credit will not be paid out or refunded to the student. The scholarship money and credit would be refunded back to CGI.
