The Doctor of Behavioral Health (DBH) program prepares integrated care professionals to deliver whole-person healthcare to diverse communities and improve quality healthcare access.

Students are trained as doctoral-level experts in integrated behavioral health, prepared to deliver patient-centered care, work collaboratively, and employ evidence-based practices and quality improvement approaches. No residency or internship is required.

At \$400 per credit hour, the DBH program at Cummings Graduate Institute for Behavioral Health Studies is the most affordable integrated behavioral healthcare doctoral degree program in the US. Scholarship opportunities are available.

About the IBH Certificate

Catalyze healthcare reform and improvement as a champion for integrated behavioral health.

The Integrated Behavioral Healthcare (IBH) certificate focuses on the use of evidence-based models of integrated behavioral health delivery for the clinical provider working in fast-paced primary care or specialty medical setting. Students are prepared as healthcare professionals to deliver integrated clinical care, consult with medical teams as a leader and integration expert, and to launch innovative practice models that offer unique value propositions to the healthcare marketplace.

Five specialty areas are offered, each reflecting the need for specific and advanced training in clinical practice with critical populations.

Adult, Gerontology, Military Families & Veterans, and Women's Health specialty tracks provide coursework to prepare students to understand the epidemiology and prevalence of mental health disorders, chronic disease, and comorbidities specific to the population of focus, as well as evidence-based interventions that effectively address these issues to improve overall health and quality of life for these populations.

The Leadership specialty prepares students to accept leadership roles in healthcare, including management and executive positions responsible for leading intrapreneurial improvement efforts and innovation and entrepreneurial challenges that address gaps in healthcare delivery settings.

About the TIC Certificate

Lead your agency, unit, or team toward becoming a trauma-informed organization.

The Trauma Informed Care (TIC) certificate provides an in-depth exploration of the impact of trauma on health outcomes. Students identify clinical and operational practices that may re-traumatize patients and lead to provider burnout and develop realistic strategies for mitigating or resolving trauma history and compassion fatigue. This certificate will prepare students to detect and use clues that the patient provides to develop a more complete understanding of the patient's struggles than they can perceive for themselves.
